WHAT IS COVERED



Travel reimbursement – Up to 360 EUR, depending on the country of origin.



Monthly support – Includes food allowance and pocket money.




Public transport – You'll receive a city travel card for daily commuting.



Health insurance – Full coverage provided by Henner throughout the entire mobility period.



Accommodation – You will be provided with a place to live, including sheets, blankets, and pillows. Wi-Fi is available in the apartment.



ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

Join a 10-month ESC project in Poland supporting an alternative school and kindergarten based on creativity, freedom, and respect.

As a volunteer, you'll be part of a vibrant community of children, teachers, and parents—contributing to daily activities, sharing your culture, and promoting diversity and solidarity.

The artistic school **Horyzonty Wyobraźni** follows non-formal education principles: learning through experience, no grades, tests, bells, or reward/punishment system. Volunteers support children and teachers in daily school life, lead creative activities, guide younger kids in everyday tasks, and share their culture through non-formal learning sessions.

ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

FIKA Kindergarten is a peaceful preschool located in the green, quiet area of Sołtysowice. Surrounded by nature, it offers a safe and creative space where children grow in a calm, caring atmosphere. The kindergarten follows a closeness-based philosophy, focusing on individual attention, warm relationships, and emotional support.

Volunteer tasks include:

Supporting children during play,
Using English for natural language immersion,
Sharing knowledge about the world and their own culture through games, songs, and creative activities.

ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

ENTE Language School promotes independence, critical thinking, and self-directed learning. Students are encouraged to set their own goals, reflect on them, and adapt to change with confidence. The school operates without bells, traditional classrooms, or desks. Everyone is treated equally and addressed by name. Learning often takes place outdoors, in close contact with nature.

ENTE Language Kindergarten supports children's independence and life skills through everyday activities like eating and cleaning, helping them build responsibility, cooperation, and self-confidence.

With a flexible schedule and freedom to choose activities, children develop at their own pace. The kindergarten emphasizes empathy, emotional expression, and a personalized approach to learning, preparing children for future challenges.

ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

Association "Ostoja" supports people with intellectual disabilities, helping them gain independence and prepare for work in real-life settings like restaurants and offices. They offer 12 workshops with small groups, covering art therapy, photography, computer skills, ceramics, music, job preparation, horticulture, and more.

Volunteer tasks include:

- Leading and assisting workshops,
- Supporting therapists,
- Running language classes,
- Helping with outings and events,
- Organizing cultural and sports activities, including an annual art festival.

“UL” Kindergarten is a multicultural preschool for 200 children aged 2.5 to 6, created for LG Energy Solutions employees. The diverse community exposes children daily to different languages, customs, and traditions, fostering openness, tolerance, and social skills from an early age.

Volunteer tasks include:

Leading language games, animations, and intercultural workshops,

Participating in daily group life,

Joining excursions, celebrations, and special events.
